Trail Condition key

Poor = Bare spots on sections of trails with little snow on connector roads.

Fair = Packed snow forming the foundation of the trail.

Good = Accumulation of packed snow forming the foundation of the trail with fallen snow top coating and groomed.

Excellent = Good plus a fresh snow cover with good density or weight of water, a packable snow depth that allows heavy traffic and will still hold up. No moguls. Trails well groomed and time allowed for trail to freeze in prior to heavy use.

CAUTION

Snowmobile Trails are open to motorized AND non-motorized recreational users, including mushers. Please share the trail!

Connector #6 will experience heavy truck traffic on weekdays and weekends.
